Field Notes

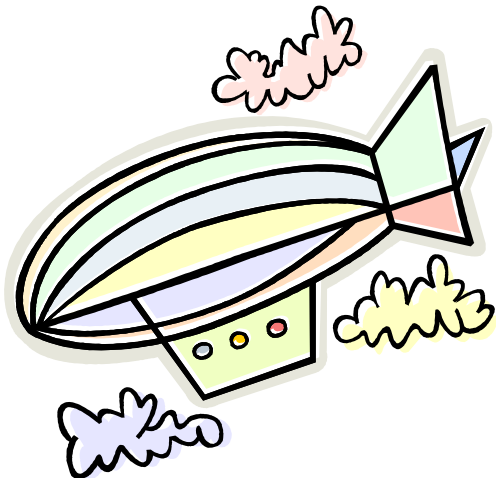
